Starting February 28th we will be reading Holes by Louis Sachar every 2nd and 4th Friday at 1:30 PΜ.





"Souped Up" Salt

The City of Summersets Public Works Department has started using a

new type of road salt/sand to help keep intersections and streets as safe as possible. Regular rock salt is ineffective below 18 degrees. With the new treated rock salt, results can be seen as low as -35 degrees. Treated salt buffers the corrosive effects of rock salt by 80% less corrosive reducing damage to vehicles, equipment, and streets.
