TRASH SERVICE REMINDERS

OUTSTANDING ACCOUNTS

Public Works runs a report every Monday to identify accounts with outstanding balances. **Accounts with any balance that is 90 days or more past due will be bypassed for trash collection.** To avoid service interruption, please ensure your payment is made before Monday at 12:00 p.m.

TRASH TOTE PLACEMENT

All trash totes must be placed at minimum of 3 feet away from any obstructions, including other totes, vehicles, fences, and mailboxes. Proper spacing ensures safe and efficient collection.

Outstanding balances may have garbage services suspended until such time the account is paid up to date. These payments must be made by noon on Monday for the garbage service to be reinstated that week.

AUTOMATIC PAYMENTS

If your account is enrolled in automatic payments, your bill will display "Paid by Draft."

Payments are withdrawn on the 20th of each month, with adjustments made as needed for weekends and holidays.

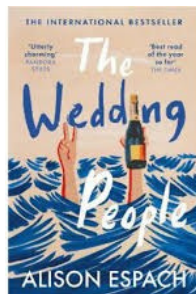

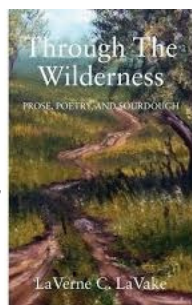
