85th Sturgis Motorcycle Rally

MOTORCYCLE SAFETY TIPS IF YOU ARE GOING TO THE 85TH STURGIS MOTORCYCLE RALLY.

1)Wear a Helmet: Helmets are optional for riders 18 and older in South Dakota, but it is highly recommended for safety. Eye protection is mandatory for all riders.

2)Lane Sharing: South Dakota allows riding two abreast in the same lane, but riders should adhere to lane sharing and passing regulations.

- **What you can't do is:** Ride between cars (aka lane splitting) – that's flat-out illegal here!

3)Stop signs and Traffic Lights: Always stop at stop signs and red lights, even if there are no other vehicles present. No rolling through, even if there's no one around.

4) Speed Limits: Speed limits are reduced during the rally, so riders should be cautious and avoid speeding tickets.

- **Here's what to expect:**

- **I-90 goes from 75 to 65 mph**
- **Highways 34 and 79 drop to 35-45 mph** near Buffalo Chip and downtown Sturgis.

5) Equipment Check: Ensure that all motorcycle equipment is legal and in good condition.

Before you even roll into Sturgis, make sure your bike is legal. Here's the quick checklist:

- Working **headlight** (1 or 2)
- At least **1 taillight**, red and visible from 500 feet

6) License, Passengers & Paperwork

- You need a **valid motorcycle license**
- If you're under 18, wear a helmet, protective eyewear, etc.
- Passengers? Make sure you've got **pegs and a proper seat**. Sitting on the fender isn't legal here.

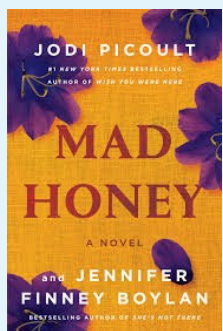
