Bill Pay Options

- Online through city website: summerset.us
- Credit Card payment over the phone (605)718-9858.
- Mail checks to 7055 Leisure Lane, Summerset, SD 57718
- Stop by City Hall to drop off checks, cash, or, alternatively, to make a credit card payment.
- Leave your payment in drop boxes located at City Hall and at the entrance of Sun Valley.
- Automatic payment from your checking account. Call City Hall for details.
- Overdue accounts need to have a payment made on them by Monday, prior to 2:00 p.m. for pick up the same week.

- RES - Residential sewer/Wastewater
- GA - Residential garbage
- SRF - Debt service
- DRES - Debt reserve
- RF - Maintenance Reserve Fee

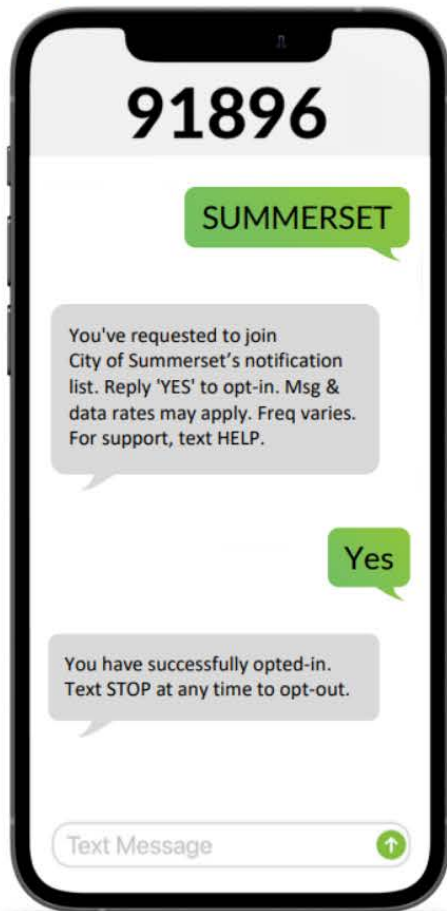

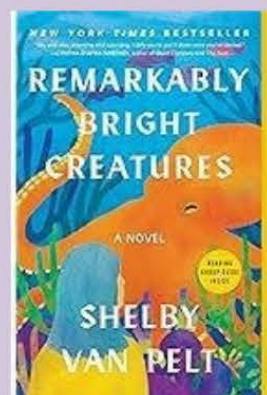
