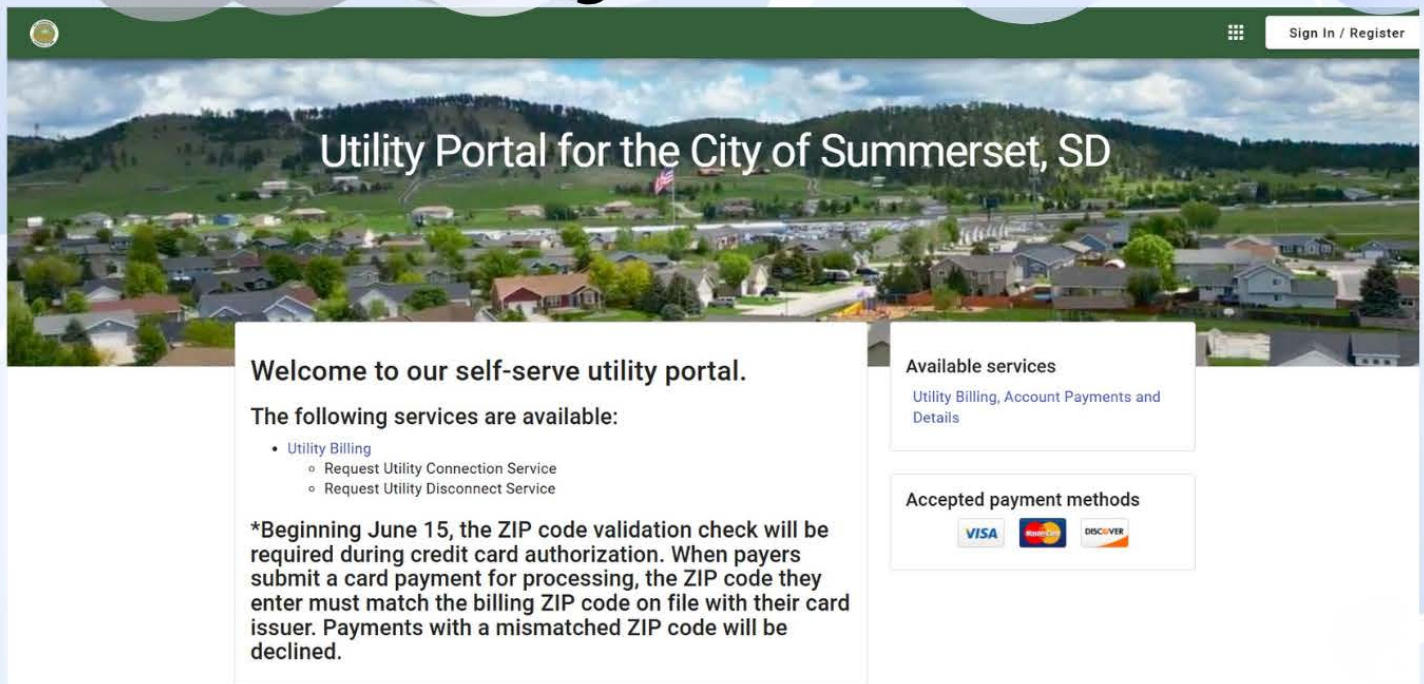
City Wide Rummage Sale

Online Credit or Debit Card Payments



Beginning June 15th, ZIP code validation will be required for all credit card payments made through the City of Summerset's online payment system. This enhanced security feature helps protect cardholders and reduce fraudulent transactions.

Please note that the City office does not store credit card numbers and cannot update or change any saved payment information on your behalf. The online payment system is fully resident-managed, meaning you enter your own card details and select any automatic payment dates. Because of this, you will need to update your payment method directly if the billing ZIP code on file is no longer correct.

To help avoid declined payments or processing delays, we encourage all residents and payers to review any saved or stored payment methods before June 15th and confirm that the billing ZIP code entered matches the ZIP code associated with your card on file with your financial institution. If your billing address or ZIP code has recently changed, please update your saved payment information as soon as possible.

As an alternative, residents may also choose automatic direct payment from a checking account. To enroll or learn more, simply look for **"Automatic Payments (ACH)"** under **Payment Options** on the City Utilities page at summerset.us. If you need any assistance, we're always happy to help at City Hall.

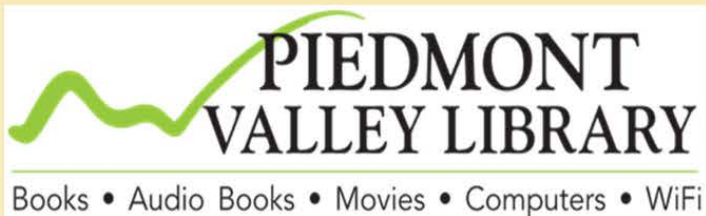

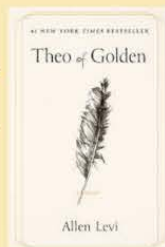
