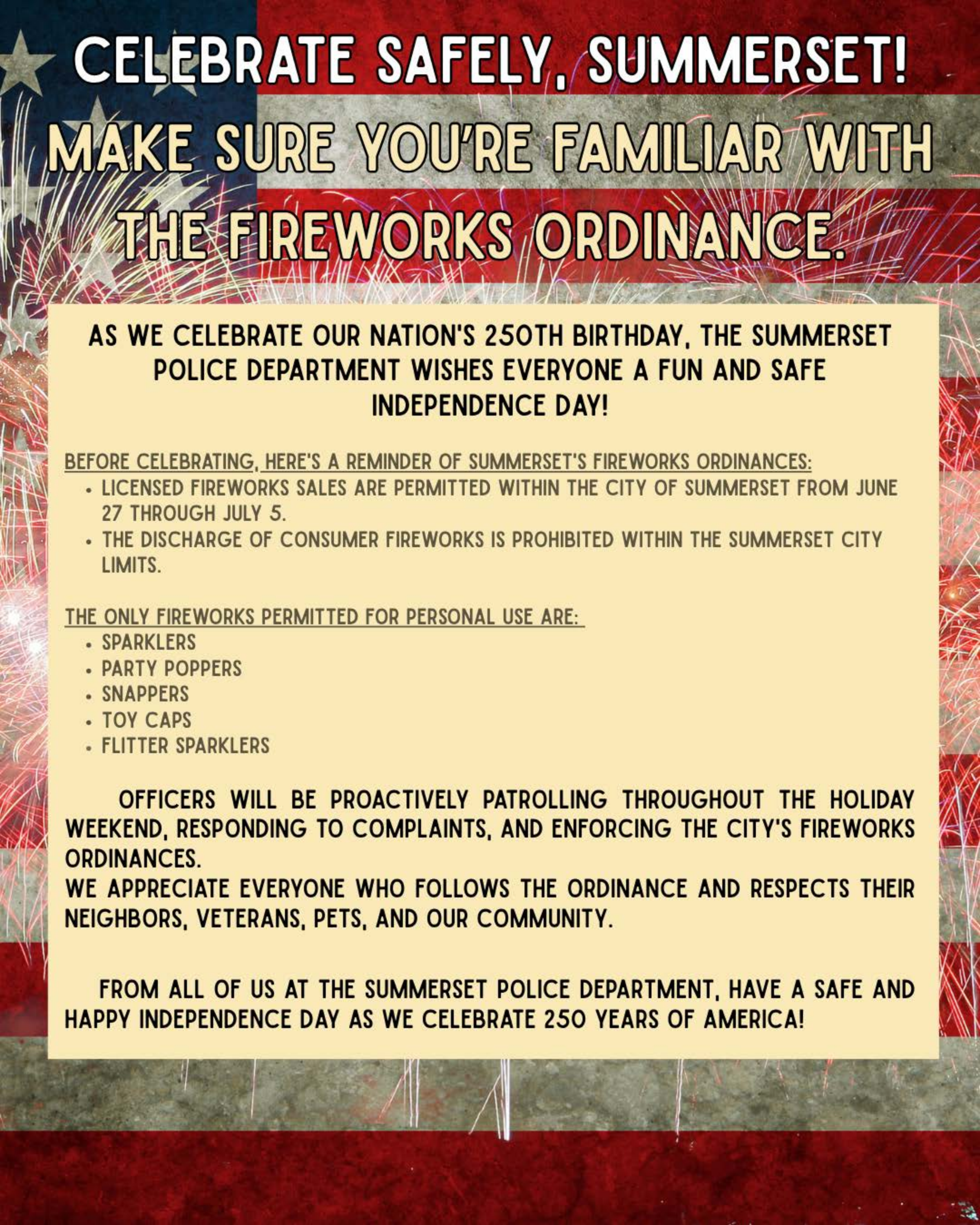

THE ONLY FIREWORKS PERMITTED FOR PERSONAL USE ARE:

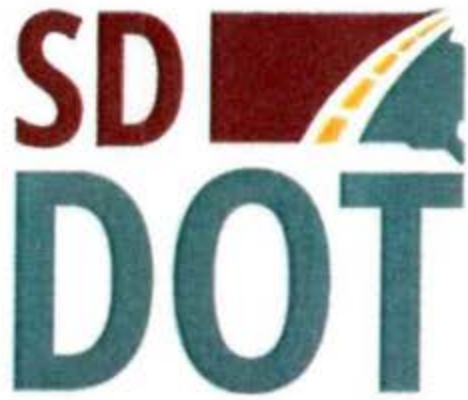
- SPARKLERS

FROM THE CITY UTILITY BILLING DESK

BILLING STATISTICS

2025

- January 2025 there were a total of 939 billed utility accounts
- 163 accounts set up for paperless billing, which is 17% of accounts
 - \$476.41 cost to mail out utility bills to 776 accounts

- December 2025 there were a total of 1051 billed utility accounts
- 456 accounts set up for **paperless billing, which is 43% of accounts**
 - \$362.95 cost to mail out utility bills to 595 accounts

BILLING STATISTICS

2026

- January 2026 there were a total of 1054 billed utility accounts
- 466 accounts set up for **paperless billing, which is 44% of accounts**
 - \$358.68 cost to mail out utility bills to 588 accounts

- June 2026 there were a total of 1058 billed utility accounts
- 514 accounts set up for **paperless billing, which is 48% of accounts**
 - \$331.84 cost to mail out utility bills to 544 accounts

WORK WITH US TO REDUCE EXPENSES

2025

In 2025, Summerset reduced mailed utility bills from 776 at the beginning of the year to 595 by year-end.

This shift lowered mailing costs by \$110 each month and reduced paper use — made possible by residents who chose to receive their utility bills by email through paperless billing.

2026 - January - June billing

By mid-year 2026, Summerset increased paperless billing enrollment from 466 to 514 accounts, reducing the number of mailed utility bills and lowering monthly mailing costs by \$26.84. **This continued progress reflects the growing number of residents who choose to receive their utility bills by email when they enroll in paperless billing.**
